

Tips for downloading your Student Aid Report from the FAFSA website

We suggest using Firefox, Edge, or Internet Explorer and you'll need to unblock pop-up windows.

1. On the My FAFSA 2020-2021 page, click View or Print your Student Aid Report (SAR).



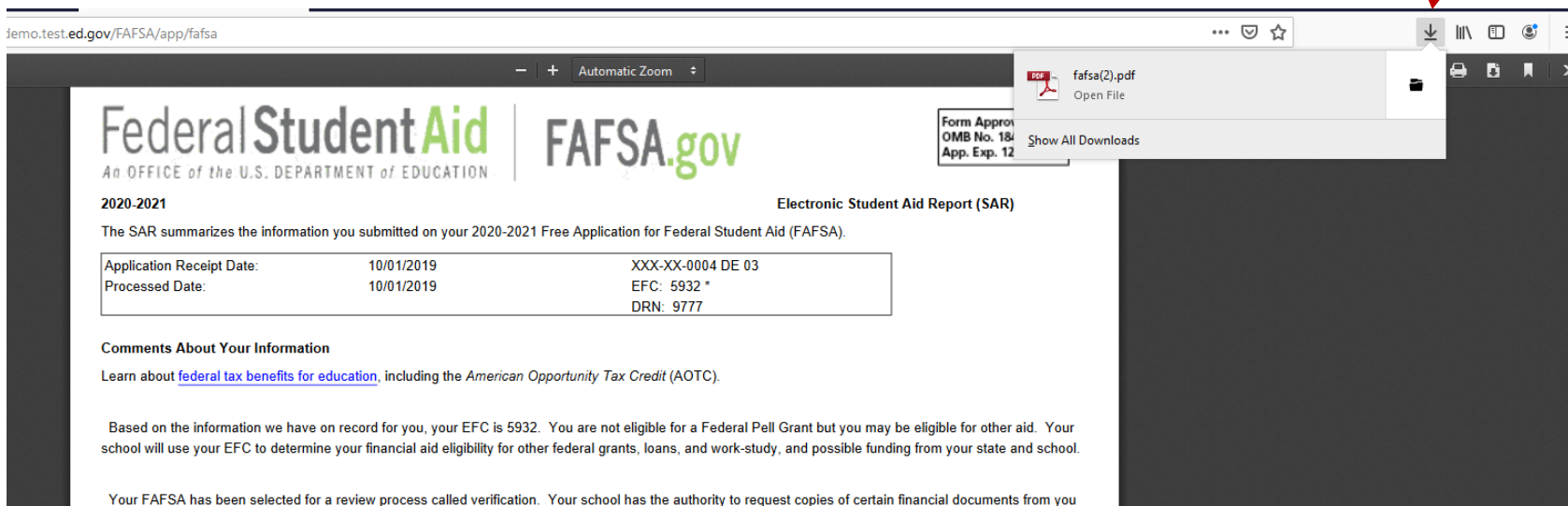

8. Check to make sure the downloaded file of your SAR has at least five pages



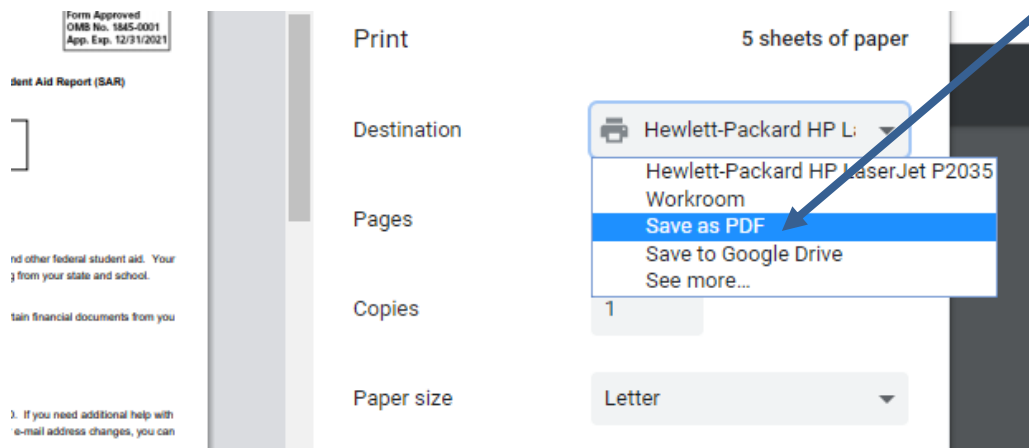
9. Upload the PDF file of your SAR into the scholarship application.

To download the PDF using Chrome:

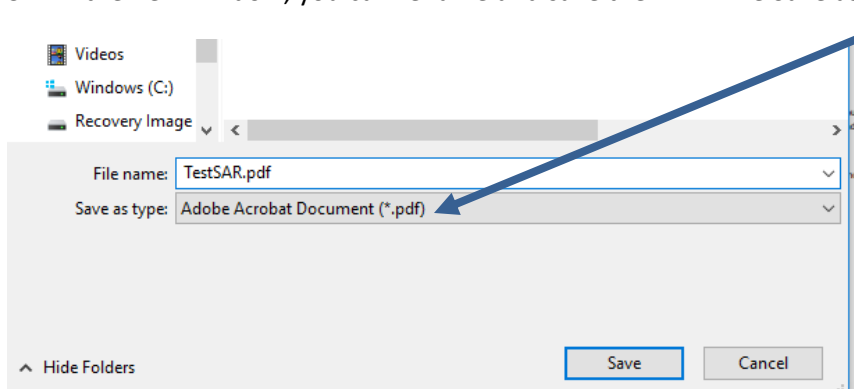
1. Choose the Print, option in the upper right corner.



2. In the Print pop up window, choose Save as PDF and click Save.



3. In the new window, you can rename and save the PDF. The Save as Type should say Adobe Acrobat Document (*.pdf)
